Summary

- 4. Unloads corn from trucks and rail cars, including weighing, sampling, and testing.
- 5. Loads ethanol and ethanol products into trucks and rail cars, including weighing, sampling, and testing, as required.
- 6. Safely moves rail cars on the plant site as necessary to facilitate effective receiving and shipping.
- 7. Assists with maintenance and repair of receiving and shipping equipment.
